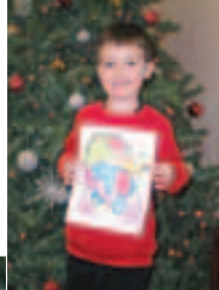

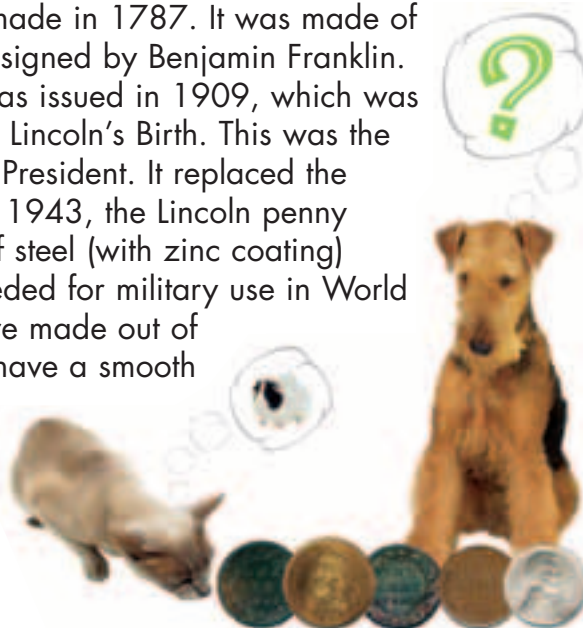

## Did you know?

### “The Penny”

The first US penny was made in 1787. It was made of pure copper and was designed by Benjamin Franklin. The first Lincoln penny was issued in 1909, which was the 100th anniversary of Lincoln’s Birth. This was the first US coin to picture a President. It replaced the “Indian Head” penny. In 1943, the Lincoln penny began to be made out of steel (with zinc coating) because copper was needed for military use in World War II. Today pennies are made out of copper plated zinc and have a smooth edge. The penny is 19.05 mm in diameter and is 1.55 mm thick. There are about 150 billion US pennies in circulation today.
